It is the intent and purpose of the Glenwood Springs Association of REALTORS® (GSAR) Scholarship Committee that these Scholarships are awarded to students interested in pursuing post-secondary education. This includes 4-year universities/colleges, community colleges, and trade schools.

The applicants for the awards may be 2026 graduates of a local high school within the Association's jurisdiction. GSAR will award two \$4,000 "Pinnacle" Scholarships to two students and other Scholarships (\$500, \$1,000, or \$2000) to applicants from the seven area high schools: Roaring Fork, Bridges, Glenwood Springs, Yampah Mountain, Coal Ridge, Rifle and Grand Valley. The Scholarship will be deposited in the recipient's name at the institution he/she is enrolled at. One-half of the Scholarship will be distributed for the Fall 2026 Semester. The second half will be distributed for the Spring 2027 Semester, as long as the student is still enrolled. If the student is not enrolled for the Fall 2026 Semester, the Scholarship will be forfeited.

The following criteria are considered important in choosing the recipient and are arranged in the order of priority.

1. Sincerity of intent to pursue post-secondary education
2. Character traits
3. Aptitude and ability to succeed
4. Extra-curricular activities, hobbies, outside interests and work experience
5. Financial need

Finalists will be invited for an in-person interview. The recipients will be named annually by the GSAR Scholarship Committee. An alternate will be selected and will receive the award or remaining portion of the unused award in the event the original recipient fails to accept it or continue his/her education.

Recipients will be notified by mail. An Award Certificate will be presented at the high school award or graduation ceremony.
